

Penelitian Baru: Lebih Banyak Wanita Dikatakan Psikopat Daripada yang Diperkirakan Sebelumnya

Description

Psychopaths are often seen as individuals who lack empathy and guilt, engaging in antisocial behaviors such as lying, manipulation, and demonstrating traits of narcissism and ruthlessness. While it has been commonly believed that male psychopaths outnumber female psychopaths, recent studies suggest that this may not be the case. One of the challenges in identifying female psychopaths is the use of psychopathy assessment tools that may be more geared towards men. Dr Boddy pointed out that the Levenson self-report psychopathy scale (LSRP) may create a gender-specific bias in psychopathy assessments, as it focuses more on violence and antisocial behavior, which are traditionally associated with male psychopaths. This creates a potential gap in accurately assessing female psychopathy.

Dr Boddy's research highlights the importance of recognizing and understanding the presence of female psychopaths in the workplace and society. He emphasized that current risk management decisions and leadership selection processes may be faulty if female psychopaths are not accurately identified and addressed. This has implications for the criminal justice system and organizational leadership decisions.

As a leading academic in the field of corporate psychopathy, Dr. Clive Boddy's research sheds light on the often overlooked presence of female psychopaths in society. By challenging traditional beliefs and ratios, his work aims to increase awareness and understanding of the behaviors and characteristics of female psychopaths. This information is crucial in developing effective risk management strategies and

leadership selection processes to better deal with the potential threats posed by female psychopaths.
